Today's Readings: 1 Kings 3:5, 7-12 [Solomon said,] "Give your servant, therefore, a listening heart to judge your people and to distinguish between good and evil. For who is able to give judgment for this vast people of yours?" **Romans 8:28-30** We know that all things work together for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose. **Matthew 13:44-52 or 13:44-46** [Jesus said,] "The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field, which a person finds and hides again, and out of joy goes and sells all that he has and buys that field."

This "treasure" does have its cost: we must actively search for it, recognize it when we find it, and sort out all the distractions that keep us from recognizing the treasure. In the gospel the seekers go out to obvious places to find the treasure. For us our discovery of the "kingdom of heaven" is most often in our everyday circumstances when we experience overwhelmingly the in-breaking of God's Presence. This may be something so simple as the smile of a person's grateful thanks or the sense of rightness that comes with fidelity to daily prayer. It may be demanding such as committing time to help those in need. The "kingdom of heaven" demands our all—and nothing less.

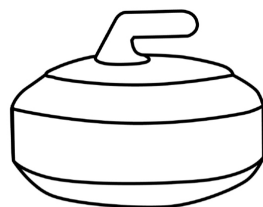
