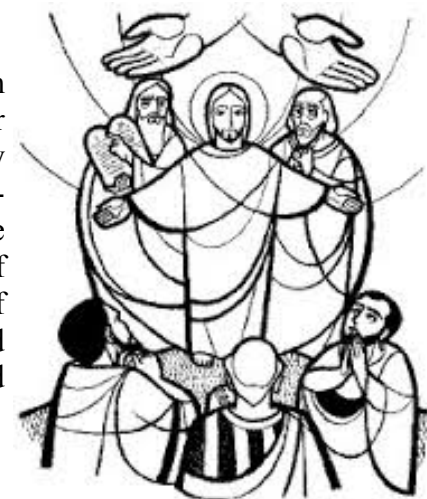

The Transfiguration of the Lord
August 6th, 2017

Today's Readings: Deuteronomy 7:9–10, 13–14 [The Lord] will love and bless and multiply you; he will bless the fruit of your womb and the produce of your soil. **2 Peter 1:16–19** "This is my Son, my beloved, with whom I am well pleased." **Matthew 17:1–9** And he was transfigured before them; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light.

In face of Jesus' transfiguration, the disciples "were very much afraid." Perhaps they were afraid of losing what was familiar to them from of old. Perhaps they were afraid because they had an inkling that this new journey presents formidable challenges. If we are to enter into Jesus' glorification, then we must be open to a transfiguration of ourselves, of our lives, of our own destiny. We must let go of our own limited vision of horizons and "listen to" Jesus opening up for us the uncharted territory of remarkable compassion and mercy, forgiveness and care, love and humility. We must allow Jesus to transfigure us.
