Fr Greg had his first meeting with this team. They have moved forward with a third simplified image. However, the artist/designer had a personal matter, so they have delayed this step for the time being.

- -They are making a few minor updates for now (for example, polishing the Tabernacle).
- -Moving slowly but still moving forward with the process.
- Small Chapel Usage and Space Update Sat 2 and 3.
- -Fr Greg changed the orientation of the chairs to make the space more intimate and cozy. Nicer for individual and small-group prayer.
- -Fr Greg put a note about the change in the bulletin Nov 2/3 to let people know that the chapel isn't intended as overflow seating. Two distinct spaces. The general rule is to keep the chapel doors closed and the curtains down.

Smaller goal(s):

5. PPC Mass Announcement for Nov 23/24

-Opportunity for the larger parish to get to know the PPC by introducing the team to the parish at each Mass. Dean has made a draft of the announcement to use at each Mass.

6. Detroit Staff Trip Update

-Positive experience for the entire staff team. It was an Acts XXIX (Rescue Project) Leadership Immersive. (Further information: https://www.actsxxix.org/leadership-immersive)

-The main principles are to 1) Reacquire a Biblical worldview (see and understand the world through the Lens of the Bible and our mission to know and love Jesus); 2) We are more than a staff—God calls us Christians as a family. This Christian family should also extend to the whole parish; 3) Restore initiative to God. So that meant that instead of coming up with our own ideas, they sent us to the chapel first before we met. We are expecting God to speak and learning to listen. Most of the week was a rhythm of chapel and then a meeting room to share what God is saying to us - and back and forth. To be led by the Lord in our conversations.

-One staff mission was A desire to seek the "lost" – a Heart of Evangelization.

Forming Parish Leadership Team (4-6 members)

-One practical recommendation from the immersive was to form a smaller Leadership Team to meet and vision-cast for the parish. "Who are we? What do we do? How do we do it?" etc. Fr Greg is looking to create a smaller, primarily staff Leadership Team to do the big picture vision. Parish Council is different. The Parish Council brings the parish's needs to the priest (various voices of the parish) – what does the parish need? Parish Leadership is kind of the opposite – what does God want for the parish? Parish Council is a "Bottom-up" ministry, whereas Leadership would be a "Top-down" ministry.

-A practical concern is whether the Leadership Team will take hours from staff's regular work, including managing day-to-day roles within the office.

-In the past, PPC performed some of both of these roles. Good to differentiate the roles.
