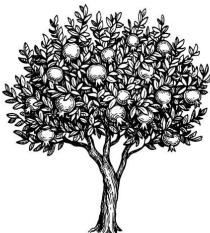

Who Are You? Really! -Sr. Dianne Bergant, CSA

Like it or not, we often get our sense of who we are from others. Some people either make us feel worthwhile or treat us like we have little value. We all want to be accepted, to be part of the crowd, to look like we have made it. This is one reason we fall for so many fads of the day: “Everyone has one.” “Everyone is doing it.” Teenagers aren’t the only ones who think like this. It may take a long time before we can move beyond the opinions of others. Many never do. So, who are you? Really! Are you hiding behind something, some pretense? Are you trying to look like someone you’re not? Today’s readings remind us, as many have said, “Actions speak louder than words,” and as Christ said, “By their fruits you will know them” (Matthew 7:16). What is deepest within us eventually shows itself. Sirach offers several examples of this. He claims that sometimes the dark side of our personalities comes out when we least expect it. But then there are times when we surprise even ourselves with our own goodness. Luke offers similar examples from both nature and human experience. Try as we might, we cannot completely hide who we truly are. And why should we? The last phrase of today’s gospel is profound: “From the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks” (Luke 6:45). That is where we find who we are. Really!
