Holy Trinity Sunday – June 15th, 2025



#### I Believe in God. -Sr. Dianne Bergant, CSA

What do we mean when we say this? We are saying that we don't understand it, but we believe it; we accept it as truth. How do we know it's true? First, we must remember that we are standing before the greatest mystery of all—the mystery of the triune God. The best we can do is open our eyes to the power of God working in our lives. Today's readings help us do that.

In the first reading, the wisdom of God takes our hand and leads us through the marvels of creation. Who has not stood in awe before a sunset, a waterfall, or the smile of an infant? We are surrounded by the wonders of the natural world—wonders that can fashion us into natural mystics and prompt us to praise our Creator. Once transformed by his encounter with the risen Christ, Paul proclaims again and again that "we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans 5:1). He knows from experience that Jesus is his Savior and the Savior of us all. We may not always realize this, but there are times in the life of each of us when we experience a profound need to be saved.

Finally, in the gospel, it was Jesus himself who promised that the "Spirit of truth" would come and strengthen our faith (John 16:13). Without that Spirit, we might simply wander about in confusion. These readings provide a glimpse into the action of God in our lives. Do we believe what they say?
