23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time –September 7th, 2025

On Sunday, September 7, 2025, the Catholic Church will celebrate the Mass of Canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati from St. Peter’s Square in the Vatican.

Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901-1925) was a young Italian man known for his deep love of God, the poor, and the outdoors. Despite coming from a wealthy family, he lived a life of simplicity and service, often giving away his money, clothes, and time to help those in need. He was passionate about justice and lived his faith boldly among friends and in the public square. Pier Giorgio was also an avid mountain climber, seeing the beauty of creation as a path to God. He died at just 24 from polio contracted while serving the sick. His joyful motto was “*Verso l’alto*”—“To the heights!”—a call to strive for holiness.

Carlo Acutis (1991-2006), known as the “Millennial Saint in the Making,” was a teenager with a deep love for the Eucharist. A skilled computer programmer, he used his talents to spread devotion to the Eucharist by creating a website documenting Eucharistic miracles around the world. Carlo lived with great faith and kindness, inspiring his peers by showing that holiness is possible at any age. Diagnosed with leukemia at 15, he offered his suffering for the Church and the pope. ANCHOR: Chronic Illness Prayer Support Group

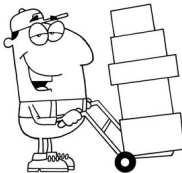
