## 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time –October 19th, 2025

### World Mission Sunday

Every year, the Church celebrates World Mission Sunday – which is marked this year on **Sunday, Oct. 19** – to remind us of the missionary dimension of our Christian vocation. The collection taken in parishes across the diocese today will support the missionary movements which the Pontifical Mission Society coordinates (the Pontifical Mission Society is also known as "Missio" in some countries).

Pope Leo XIV chose the theme: "**Missionaries of Hope Among All Peoples**" which focuses on our responsibility to bring hope to everyone. He challenges us to prayer and community building as two effective means of sustaining hope in a world of despair. Pope Leo has released a video message urging every Catholic parish in the world to take part: "Thank you for helping me to help missionaries throughout the world."
