Meeting commenced 7:07pm

1. Opening Prayer: Fr Matthew led a reflection on the upcoming Sunday Gospel

2. Approval of minutes and matters arising from the minutes.

The Chair brought forward the decision item to approve the Draft November 3, 2022 Minutes, as presented. The motion was duly moved and seconded. The vote was concluded as all in favour with not abstentions or objections and carried as unanimous. The motion was approved.

3. Approval of Agenda

The Chair would like to add the **Review of action item: Don and Val will work out the logistics of the bulletin board.** Fr Matthew would like to add a **Donation discussion under finance council update**. The motion to approve the agenda as amended was duly moved and seconded. The vote was concluded as all in favour with not abstentions or objections and carried as unanimous. The motion was approved.

4. State of the Parish Updates

Father Matthew provided data on Mass attendance over 2018 to 2022, for review and feedback. The numbers from post-covid are still lower than prior to the lockdown.

November 2018: 952 November 2019: 934 November 2020: N/A November 2021: 469 November 2022: ~548

Noted the data was still missing the last week of November so the numbers may be adjusted.

There was a lively discussion about how to personally invite people back to Mass. If people are still uncomfortable, it is hard to tell them they need to feel more comfortable. How do we respect people who feel uncomfortable while still encouraging those who have become complacent? Prayer is important: praying for people to see that they need God. Question arose as to whether we will continue livestreaming.

Does that give people an excuse to stay home? It is also an important option for those who are unable to attend Mass. As of now, we intend to continue. Fr Matthew brought up starting a "Can you ever come back to church?" campaign in the new year. Using posters and social media to pose that question and see what kind of response we'd get. Dean suggested personally calling and touching base with parishioners who haven't been there since Covid. Reaching out. Discussion about what that would look like.

ACTION ITEM #1: All pray on this question. Look for opportunities to reach out to people who haven't come vet.

ACTION ITEM #2: Heather will look into introducing a Welcome Desk/Host role for the Christmas Masses.

5. Finance Council Update from November 2022 Meeting

We will update the numbers in January. We are on track for our budget.

Fr Matthew shared that the parish has received a donation in the amount of \$15,000. As the parish has not received large donations like this in the past, there is no precedent as to how to choose where to put it so Father Matthew asked for advisement.

The three areas that Fr Matthew presented as possible areas of need were: sound system, piano, and aesthetic upgrades to the parish (new Tabernacle). What is our most pressing need? The donors have not indicated a specific area or special project that they want this to be applied to.

ACTION ITEM #3: All pray on it and discern how we should spend it. Do we need to put a process into place?

ACTION ITEM #4: Fr Matthew will talk to Ken about increasing the piano tuning maintenance.

6. Strategic Planning Exercise Update

"Reaching out in faith" is our weakest area. Maybe we need to revisit the groups in our parish and see how each group can better evangelize. We could ask each group to see how they see their group. We will revisit in a year to see how things have changed: what did you intend, what did it actually do?

ACTION ITEM #5: Fr Matthew will do a review with the staff.

7. Other Business

Review of action item(s): Don and Val will work out the logistics of the bulletin board.

Draft for Community Bulletin Board:

- Use existing bulletin board: 3' x 2'
- Half page size maximum
- Time limits contingent on type of request (for example, request for rides to Mass ongoing)
- Father Matthew + Staff would have final approval of what is posted.

What other parameters/criteria? Not personal gain/business-based. Do we need to have a disclaimer that St Anne's is not liable?

ACTION ITEM #6: Father Matthew will bring it to the staff for Trina/Erin to work with to start it.
