- Father Matthew spoke with Jan Bigland-Pritchard (Diocesan Director of Migration). The parish can only have one refugee committee. So the work will still be officially under the current Refugee Committee as long as Carmen Koss does not take on any of the work load.

## 4. Staff update, farewell, and discernment

- We're going to have a guest at the rectory for the summer. Huy Le is a seminarian for the diocese. He's from Saskatoon and has just finished his first year theology studies. The plan is for him to get a job for the summer, so there's no expectation on him to take on any ministries here other than serving at Sunday Masses. He will help with some of the extra duties while Fr Matthew is away (Adoration, bringing Communion to the etc). When he is available, he'll serve at Mass.
- Patti Pasloski, current Children's Coordinator, is retiring at the end of May. She has been here for 10 years.

- The new Children's Coordinator (CC) will be full-time (37.5 hours). This means that Trina (currently 7.5 hours of children's ministry) will take less children's hours. Fr Matthew hopes to move Trina to more of a Ministry of Care role.
- The new CC will have some freedom to do other types of children's ministry not
  necessarily Kids for Christ (current program). Fr Matthew would also like the new CC to work
  to make the school visits translate to parish involvement.
- The hiring process is that the job opening will start May 6/7 weekend and close on May 25th. Interviews in June. Looking for someone who shares the vision of the parish, loves Jesus, active prayer life, love for children, experience working with children.
- Interview Process. It is usually a PPC member, Fr Matthew, and 1 staff member.
- Job Advertisement Plan: Bulletin, Snapshot, Facebook Page, Diocesan Bulletin, STM Campus Ministry (Michael McLean), CCO, St Therese,
- Fr Matthew will speak to the Diocesan HR team to arrange an exit interview with Patti.
- Parish Farewell for Patti will be May 14<sup>th</sup> at the Pancake Breakfast (10am). Trina is going to
  take the lead by confirming Patti's attendance, choosing a couple of parishioners to say nice
  things, and coordinating with some kids and schools to make cards. Val will see if she is
  available that day to speak on behalf of PPC.
